Staci Wright was born June 9, 1992, in Eugene, Oregon. Growing up, she was very shy but loved to play sports, especially soccer. She went from Jefferson Middle School to South Eugene High School where she continued to play soccer and make friends.

In January of 2006, Staci was diagnosed with Ewing Sarcoma, a cancer that develops from a tumor in the bones or soft tissue. To fight the cancer, she endured ten months of chemotherapy treatments as frequent as five times per week every three weeks. At one point, Staci had to have radiation therapy every day for five weeks. Staci began to lose her beautiful red hair as a result from the radiation. It was hard to feel normal around her peers until she discovered the high-quality wigs produced by Amy's Presence. Once she had her own wig, she began to feel better about herself. "It gave me the security and comfort of being able to live like a normal teen," Staci recalls. She promptly started the Angel Hair Foundation with her mother, Deborah Wright, to give the same benefit to other children and teens in Oregon who are suffering from hair loss due to a medical condition.

Over two years later, Staci is cancer-free and enjoys her life playing soccer for South Eugene High School and Eugene Metro Futbol Club while going to school and hanging out with friends. In the future, Staci plans to attend college to study nutrition. She hopes to continue the success of Angel Hair and expand the organization to other states so that she can help more children regain their confidence.
